




PLANTING INFORMATION

HOW TO PLANT A TREE PROPERLY



Hole should be 10in wider and 2-3in shallower than depth of the root ball.

Leave burlap, metal cage, and rope on. Top with 3in of mulch, keeping it 2in away from the trunk.

The soil under the root ball needs to be SOLID and compacted.

HOW TO DIG THE HOLE

Dig the hole approximately 2-3in shallower than the depth of the root ball and at least 10in wider than the diameter of the root ball. **Remember: PLANT HIGH, WON'T DIE. PLANT LOW, WON'T GROW.**

WHICH MATERIALS TO REMOVE

Do not remove burlap or twine, Breezy Hill Nursery uses a biodegradable burlap & twine which should remain on the tree. Leave the wire basket around the root ball, future roots will grow around and through it. After one year, cut the rope around the trunk of the tree at the base.

HOW TO FILL THE HOLE

Mix 70% of the soil you dug out with 30% of a compost soil to use as backfill. Fill with 1/3rd of the soil mixture and pack around the root ball. Water thoroughly to remove any air pockets and settle the soil. Finish filling the hole and water thoroughly.

HOW TO MULCH ONCE PLANTED

Place a 2-3in layer in a circle around the tree and extend 2in outwards from the trunk. Elevate the mulch around the drip line to allow water to collect in the correct area (see diagram). Pull mulch back from the trunk to allow air circulation.

HOW TO WATER

The goal is to slowly & deeply water the plant's root system & the surrounding planting pit. Rainfall, soil type, & weather will determine your watering schedule.

New trees and shrubs should be watered 2x a week for the first two weeks, then 1x a week after that when following the times and guidelines below. Please monitor drought conditions for extended watering times as needed.

Trees:

Potted 1.5" Caliper & Below // 3-4ft Evergreen

20 – 30 min (hose on slow trickle) per plant

2" – 2.5" Caliper // 5-6ft Evergreen

30 – 45 min (hose on slow trickle) per plant

3" Caliper & Above // 7ft & Above Evergreen

1 – 2 hours (hose on slow trickle) per plant

Shrubs:

Potted and Small B&B

20 – 30 min (hose on slow trickle) per plant

Perennials:

2 min (watering wand) per plant

PRUNING & STAKING

At this time, prune only dead, injured, or crossing branch to promote good growth and structure. Do not use tree wound paint. For staking, it is recommended if on a hill or windy location. Make sure to remove at the end of the first year.

HOW TO CHECK IF YOUR PLANT IS STILL ALIVE

Scratch the bark! If you see bright green, it means it is still alive! If you see a dull green, almost brown, the plant could be declining.

WARRANTY INFORMATION

Breezy Hill Nursery offers a **Two Year Limited Guarantee** that covers plants and trees purchased and installed by Breezy Hill Nursery. The coverage period is **two years** from your invoice of job completion. BHN will replace, free of charge, any shrub, evergreen, or tree found defective within the terms of this warranty. This warranty does not cover the labor to remove the dead material. The installation of the replacement or delivery fees of the replacement. These expenses are the responsibility of the customer.

WHAT IS NOT COVERED BY THIS WARRANTY?

Due to the lack of hardiness to our area, **perennials, grasses, bulbs, annual flowers, Japanese Maples, tropical plants, Clematis, Azaleas, Rhododendron, Butterfly bushes, Bluebeard and houseplants are not covered in our warranty**. We **only** guarantee roses until November 1st of the year they were purchased. All evergreen trees and shrubs not listed above purchased after October 31st will not carry a warranty.

This warranty does not cover plants that do not survive due to failure to provide normally accepted horticultural planting care and/or maintenance. This includes not following BHN watering and planting guidelines. Trees/shrubs planted too deep will fall under this statement.

This warranty does not include transportation, labor, or other consequential and incidental costs or damages. All trees and shrubs must be covered with a tarp before leaving Breezy Hill Nursery. Customer has the right to refuse tarp and all warranties will be void.

This warranty does not include coverage of the following: **damage or loss of trees, plants, or ground covers caused by fires, floods, lightning, hail, freezing rains, winds, or storms over 75 miles per hour; Winter kill caused by extreme cold and severe winter conditions or drought and/or not typical of planting area; natural disasters; or acts of vandalism**.

This warranty does not cover damage caused by animal rubbing or eating. It is the sole responsibility of the owner to protect plants from the possible damage by animals.

HOW DO I OBTAIN REPLACEMENTS?

Customers must contact Breezy Hill Nursery within **two years** from the date of invoice. Liability is limited to the replacement of plants and/or trees of the same comparable plants and/or trees. **No credits or refunds will be given**.

This warranty is subject to payment of the original invoice being made within the terms of sale and account must be current. Customer must provide original receipt at time of requesting a warranty replacement.

Once plant material is pulled and the order is cancelled there is a **30% RESTOCKING FEE** based on the price of the plant material.

Customer must provide original receipt at time of requesting a warranty replacement. Warranty covers only the original purchase. Delivery, installation, and delivery fees are not included in the replacement.
